

Suggestions received have ranged from arranging more visits to industries to providing more exposure to students. Some noteworthy suggestions are as follows


- a. Practical portion in the curriculum needs to be upgraded and revised as per industry requirements




Employer's Feedback on Curriculum

In your opinion how frequently should the syllabi be updated?



Report On Teachers' Feedback on Curriculum


Kanya Maha Vidyalaya values the feedback from teachers on the curriculum. Feedback has been randomly taken from twenty-six teachers across different streams. Under Autonomous, all the departments have conducted their Board of Studies being head of the department as chairperson, two subject experts from outside the parent university, one subject expert nominee from the parent university, and other faculty teachers as members of BOS for finalizing the syllabi of all UG and PG classes. Our college teachers with valuable suggestions from experts have revised and upgraded the syllabi with 21st-century global skills. Internship, Industrial Training, and other practical pieces of training have been incorporated into the syllabi depending on the course curriculum.

The major findings are as follows:

- Sixty-five percent of teachers are highly satisfied with the depth of course content and thirty-five percent of teachers are satisfied with it.

What do you feel about the depth of the course content?









Do you favour internal assessment?



How do you view fieldwork / project work in the curriculum?




Report on Students' Feedback on Curriculum

How do you view the syllabi of the concerned subjects ?




I) Analysis of Survey






Where do you live?


Are you well connected to Internet?










Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers








































The teachers' methods helped in understanding the topic better








